Executive Summary

This first mission on the sub component was primarily used for assessing the current situation regarding retail trade statistics in KAS and to assist with planning and recommendations towards first publication.

The current situation regarding retail trade statistics in KAS is briefly described as follows:

- A sample was drawn from SBR by the end of 2012 and has been used for collection of survey data since then
- Survey data has been collected on a quarterly basis for the six quarters from beginning of 2013 to 2nd quarter of 2014
- Data has been collected and entered into a database
- Data has not yet been error checked and edited
- No imputations or estimations have been performed yet
- The plan is to publish quarterly figures for 2013-2014 by April 2015

The current sample was drawn with aid from an IMF expert. The population came from SBR and the statistical unit is enterprise. The population was stratified by 4-digit Nace rev. 1.1 activity codes. The largest enterprises in each stratum were chosen for the sample, and thereafter random enterprises were chosen until 80 pct. turnover coverage was obtained in each stratum.

The sample design makes it difficult to calculate weights for the enterprises in the sample. It was thus decided to do calculations without weights. This means that no grossing up of the survey data to the full population will be performed, and even more importantly no weighting to compensate for non-response within the sample will be applied. The latter makes it absolutely necessary to perform imputations for all non-response. During the mission various imputation methods were discussed.

The plan to publish figures for 2013-2014 by April 2015 seems ambitious, especially since at this stage only unedited data is available. However, since the methodology to be implemented is rather limited because of the lack of estimation, it is not impossible. It is essential to do a thorough work on error checking, editing and imputation before compiling totals and calculate indices.

It is recommended to follow the detailed plan in annex 4 towards first publication.

Future topics for further development of the statistics were also discussed briefly. Most points on the below list are topics to be covered in order to eventually be in compliance with the STS regulation. It is important to emphasize that a complete implementation of this lies well ahead in the future.

- Introduce other means of data collection (letters, e-mails, web forms, smart phone app)
- Improved IT systems to better facilitate error checking and editing, imputation
- New sample and new sample design (stratified simple random sampling with take-all and cut-off)
- Monthly data collection and publication

- Complete transition to Nace rev. 2
- Estimation according to new sample design, possibly with ratio estimation
- Deflation by CPI
- Seasonal and calendar adjustment

Next mission

There is one more mission planned for this sub component. It is recommended to have this mission in September next year, and obvious actions during this mission would be:

- Assessment of the published data and the methods used
- Assistance in introducing a new sample
- Assistance in introducing estimation methods

1. General comments

This mission report was prepared within the Twinning Project "Support to Statistics". It was the first mission on sub component 3.3 regarding retail trade.

The concrete objectives of the mission were:

- A general assessment of the current situation regarding retail trade statistics in KAS.
- Short term planning towards first publication of retail trade data.

The consultants would like to express their thanks to all officials and individuals met for the kind support and valuable information which they received during the stay in Kosovo, and which highly facilitated the work of the consultants. All local experts showed great interest in the topics covered and thereby contributed to the success of this mission. Also a special thanks to the highly qualified interpreter.

The views and observations stated in this report are those of the consultants and do not necessarily correspond to the views of EU, KAS or Statistics Denmark.

2. Assessment and results

The current situation regarding retail trade statistics in KAS is briefly described as follows:

- A sample was drawn from SBR by the end of 2012 and has been used for collection of survey data since then
- Survey data has been collected on a quarterly basis for the six quarters from beginning of 2013 to 2nd quarter of 2014
- Data has been collected and entered into a database
- Data has not yet been error checked and edited
- No imputations or estimations have been performed yet
- The plan is to publish quarterly figures for 2013-2014 by April 2015

Sample

The current sample was drawn with aid from an IMF expert. The population came from SBR and the statistical unit is enterprise. The population was stratified by 4-digit Nace rev. 1.1 activity codes. The largest enterprises in each stratum were chosen for the sample, and thereafter random enterprises were chosen until 80 pct. turnover coverage was obtained in each stratum. The sample size ended at about 580 enterprises.

Data collection and questionnaires

Data is primarily collected via face-to-face interviews. The response rate is about 60 pct. The questionnaire used can be found in annex 3. During the mission the questionnaire was evaluated.

Error checking and editing

The data needs error checking an editing. During the mission various methods were discussed and hands-on examples were treated in Excel.

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Imputation and estimation

The sample design makes it difficult to calculate weights for the enterprises in the sample. It was thus decided to do calculations without weights. This means that no grossing up of the survey data to the full population will be performed, and even more importantly no weighting to compensate for non-response within the sample will be applied. The latter makes it absolutely necessary to perform imputations for all non-response. During the mission various imputation methods were discussed.

Publication

A detailed plan for the activities towards first publication was made during this mission. See Annex 4. It was agreed upon to limit the first publication to retail trade turnover and number of employees only.

Other activities

In addition to the activities in connection with the assessment of the current status mentioned above, a number of other topics were also discussed during this mission:

- Summary of EU regulation on retail trade statistics
- Introduction to Danish methodology and practice regarding the production of retail trade statistics, in particular regarding imputation techniques
- Introduction to seasonal adjustment
- Long term planning

3. Conclusions and recommendations

A number of conclusions and recommendations came out of this mission.

Sample and estimation

The current sample design is not fit for estimation. The consequences are that the development of smaller enterprises is underestimated and that the extend of imputation gets very high. A new sample including a new sample design should be introduced by the end of 2015. A simple stratified random sample design is recommended, making the introduction of simple estimation methods possible. The sample should include a take-all limit and a cut-off based on VAT turnover.

Data collection and questionnaire

Sometime in the future the use of face-to-face interviews should probably be diminished. Although it probably increases the response it seems to be a time consuming and expensive collection method. The EU regulation demands monthly figure on retail trade turnover, so at some point a monthly data collection must be introduced to be in compliance with this regulation.

It was agreed that the split of retail turnover in export and domestic turnover is unnecessary. A number of questions in the questionnaire are only needed on a quarterly basis, either because they are only included for the benefit of National Accounts or because the regulation only demands quarterly data. When monthly data collection is introduced all these questions can be limited to a quarterly survey.

Time plan and planning ahead

The plan to publish figures for 2013-2014 by April 2015 seems ambitious, especially since at this stage only unedited data is available. However, since the methodology to be implemented is rather limited because of the lack of estimation, it is not impossible. It is essential to do a thorough work on error checking, editing and imputation before compiling totals and calculate indices.

It is recommended to follow the detailed plan in annex 4 towards first publication.

The main focus of this mission was on assessing the current situation and the planning towards first publication. However, future topics for further development of the statistics were also discussed briefly. Most points on the below list are topics to be covered in order to eventually be in compliance with the STS regulation. It is important to emphasize that a complete implementation of this lies well ahead in the future.

Description of the background for the activity

In the report from the overall mission on business statistics by mr. Peter Ottosen and mr. Søren Netterstrøm it is stated that data collection for Retail Trade started in 2013. The sample in 2013 was 580 enterprises from a frame of 16,000. The response rate was approximately 70-80 per cent in the first three quarters of 2013. Currently (February 2014) data collection for fourth quarter is being performed. Data collection for Retail Trade is done by an external company engaged to do a number of data collections. Industrial Production and Construction are collected by the seven regional offices of KAS. No data processing has been done for any of the STS statistics and no results have been published

This first mission on retail trade statistics survey in Kosovo should focus on introducing methodology and EU requirements for this statistics. The objective for the Twinning project is to publish Retail Trade, Industrial Production and Construction indices before the end of the project in December 2015.

A long term development plan for the retail trade statistics should be prepared in order for KAS to fulfil the requirements of the EU-legislation.
