
INTRODUCTION TO STATISTICS LITHUANIA

- ❑ **6 September 1919** The General Department of Statistics was founded
 - 1923 Law on Population Census
 - 1930 Law on Statistics
- ❑ **1940–1990** Lithuanian statistics became part of the Soviet statistical system
- ❑ **18 April 1990** the Department of Statistics to the Government of the Republic of Lithuania was founded
 - 1993** Law on Statistics of the Republic of Lithuania was adopted by the Lithuanian Parliament (amended in 1999)
 - 2004** Accession to EU
 - 2015** Accession to Euro zone

- Regulation (EC) No 862/2007 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 11 July 2007 on Community statistics on migration and international protection and repealing Council Regulation (EEC) No 311/76 on the compilation of statistics on foreign workers

HISTORY OF VITAL STATISTICS IN LITHUANIA [1]

- ❑ The number of live births, deaths, marriages, divorces by national level is comparable since 1950.
- ❑ Records of marriage, divorce, birth and death were filled out by Civil Registry Offices.
- ❑ Till 2004, the second copies of these acts together with the medical certificates of death are forwarded twice a month to the respective territorial Statistical Offices which subsequently sent them on to Statistics Lithuania. Coding and further processing of information was carried out in Statistics Lithuania.
- ❑ Since 2004, Consular institutions of the Republic of Lithuania also register marriages, births and deaths of citizens of the Republic of Lithuania.

Copies of births, marriages, divorces and deaths records as well as medical certificates of deaths are submitted to the Residents' Register Service twice a month by the Civil Registry Offices of the cities / towns and districts municipalities.

Data of the Residents' Register in On-line mode as well as records of acts of civil status were submitted to Statistics Lithuania. In the database of the Demographic Statistics the required data are formed from the acts records by the programming means. These data were complemented with statistical data from records of acts of civil status and medical deaths certificates.

HISTORY OF VITAL STATISTICS IN LITHUANIA [2]

- ❑ Since 2010, mortality data by causes have been produced by Institute of Hygiene.
- ❑ In 2013, after the 2011 Population Census the revision of number live births for period 2002-2012 have been done.
- ❑ In 2015, the methodology of using additional data sources Compulsory Health Insurance Fund information system (Sveidra) (methodology under preparation) and State Social Insurance Fund Board under the Ministry of Social Security and Labour (Sodra) (methodology under preparation) for production fertility statistics under development.

HISTORY OF INTERNATIONAL MIGRATION STATISTICS IN LITHUANIA [1]

- ❑ The number of the **immigrants** and the number of **emigrants** by national level are comparable since 1990. The number of immigrants and emigrants by different breakdowns, i.e. age, sex, citizenship, country of birth, etc. is comparable since 2001.
- ❑ Statistics of external migration accounts all persons who depart from Lithuania or arrive in Lithuania with the intention of residing for a period longer than one year.
- ❑ Till the 1 July 2004, emigrating or immigrating persons shall notify their territorial Migration Office where a due statistical form, i.e. either a departure or arrival form is filled out. These forms serve as the basis for statistical account.
Each month these forms are forwarded by Migration Offices to territorial Statistical Offices that subsequently send them to Statistics Lithuania. Coding and further processing of information is carried out in Statistics Lithuania.
- ❑ Since 2004, Residents' Register data has been used to compile the international and internal migration statistics.
- ❑ Data on refugees and asylum seekers are received from the Migration Department, data on persons who were admitted to the Lithuanian citizenship – from the Office of the President of the Republic of Lithuania.

HISTORY OF INTERNATIONAL MIGRATION STATISTICS IN LITHUANIA [2]

- ❑ Since 2006, personal data (beginning and end of employment) from the database of the State Social Insurance Fund's Board has been used to measure the employment of emigrants before emigration and data from the Statistical Business Register – to measure the employment of emigrants before emigration by economic activity of the previous workplace.
- ❑ Since 1 July 2007, citizens of the Republic of Lithuania, foreign nationals and stateless persons declare their residence at a ward office at which they have arrived and from which they depart, while before – at a regional police office, subdivision, group or passport office (migration service) of their place of residence.
- ❑ Since 2008, international migration statistics has been produced following an Regulation No 862/2007 on international migration statistics.

HISTORY OF INTERNATIONAL MIGRATION STATISTICS IN LITHUANIA [3]

- ❑ In 2006–2010, the undeclared emigration surveys had been carried out for estimation the number of emigrants, who have not declared their departure in 2001-2009.
- ❑ Since 2010, data from Foreigners Register has been used about the immigration of the citizens of EU member states.
- ❑ Based on the final results of the 2011 Population and Housing Census of the Republic of Lithuania and statistical surveys conducted in 2006–2010, which served as a basis for the estimation of undeclared emigration flows in 2001–2009; the number of emigrants and the number of internal migrants for 2001–2009 had been recalculated.
- ❑ Since 2014, the Undeclared migration study based on the estimation from LFS, administrative data sources has been done.
