
ARMSTATBANK.AM is introduced as part of the EU project, Forwarding Armenian Statistics Through Twinning.

The objective of the Twinning Project is to upgrade six specific statistical fields within the National Statistical Service of the Republic of Armenia (NSSRA). This upgrade includes a comprehensive quality management framework and compilation methodologies closely aligned to European Union standards.

The project purpose is to support the National Statistical Service of the Republic of Armenia through institutional twinning with the aim of upgrading specific elements and sectors of the Armenian system of official statistics.


How do I get my data from ARMSTATBANK.AM?

Step 1. Enter the web address ARMSTATBANK.AM on your computer to get the following screen. Then, choose the topic in which you are interested:


Step 2. Within each topic a number of statistical tables are accessible. Choose the table you want to work with:


