
National Accounts

- Improved the exhaustiveness of the statistics behind the measurement of the economic growth in Jordan by including new estimates on the informal sector
- Established the most detailed description of the Jordanian economy to date by establishing a supply and use table for 2010
- Established the basis for improved evidence based macroeconomic planning by compiling an input-output table for 2010
- Prepared for implementing the changes following the 2008 System of National Accounts handbook

Sampling Techniques

- Increased the DoS staff skills on how to make the results of the surveys DoS conducts even more precise
- ...also be asking less people or companies
- Discussed how seasonal adjustment of time series could be implemented in the short-term statistics published by DoS



Quality and Metadata

- Assured the quality of statistics published by DoS by developing tools to be used for quality assurance during the steps in the compilation of statistics
- Improved the documentation of DoS' statistics by preparing quality declarations for many of DoS' statistics and publish them on DoS' website
- Designed a quality audit, which will facilitate constant care and focus on quality in DoS' work also in the future
- Prepared a metadata strategy



IT and Online Dissemination

- Improved IT-security by addressing technical as well as organizational aspects
- Restructured DoS' database structure and by that laid the foundation for improved online dissemination
- Launched a new DoS website on 12th April 2015
- Launched a new DoS online databank on 12 April 2015, where users of DoS' statistics can retrieve data in a format of their own wish

- 38 experts from five different EU member states delivered 48 missions in Jordan. In addition four study visits to Denmark, Italy and Latvia

- Training courses, presentations and discussions among DoS, users of DoS' statistics and MS experts and practical work at the desk
