> This is the fourth newsletter on the progress of the EU funded Twinning Project 'Strengthening the Capabilities of the Department of Statistics in Jordan'

During the previous three months fifteen activities were implemented. Three of those were study visits to Denmark, Italy and Latvia respectively.

The overall progress of the project is good and there is a high commitment from DoS as well as the MS experts.

Two activities were dedicated to improving the DoS website and the technology behind it. Developing a new website is not only about technical solutions. Developing a new website is very much a common effort where experts on IT and experts on communication and dissemination together with statisticians need to bring together all of their expertise and as a common effort build the new website.

A website reflects the mission and value of an organization and is thus the window to the public. In these days, where finding information on the Internet is the main source for users of statistics, it is crucial to have a good and user friendly website with all relevant information that users can easily access. The technical solutions decided for a new website should reflect all this.

During the two activities, the experts from ISTAT brought in all their expertise, experience and excitement
