- consumer price index
- industrial production
- structural business statistics [experts from Finland and Slovak Republic ]

2) Improvement of the dissemination data base and marketing of statistical data

3) Launching the Monitoring of Administrative Response Burden

4) Improvement of Work within Human Resources Management of the SSSU



## EXPECTED RESULTS

- (13 mandatory results by each statistical area included)
- national methodology and time series calculation at selected areas harmonized with the EU standards
- standards and classifications at selected areas introduced and new definitions prepared
- the dissemination database upgraded with latest version
- monitoring response burden launched in Ukraine
  personnel management system in SSSU improved
