### Air and GHG Indicators

- Emission of air pollutants from fuel combustion (by consumer/fuel type)
  - Manufacturing industry (Electricity)
  - Transportation
  - Households
  - Sources: Ministry of Infrastructures (fuel consumption), Ministry of Transport (vehicle and Km traveled) ICBS, Israel Electric Corp.
- > Air pollutants concentrations in selected monitoring stations
  - Commercial Urban Centers
  - Industrial Areas
  - Residential Areas
  - Traffic Stations
  - Source: MoEP



#### Air and GHG- Data sources

- National greenhouse gases inventory
  - Energy Industries
  - Manufacturing industries and construction (both energy and industrial processes)
  - Transportation
  - Solid waste
  - Wastewater (reports to UNFCCC)
  - Sources:
    - CBS (surveys and administrative data)
    - Ministry of Agriculture
    - MoEP
    - Ministry of Industry, Trade and Labor
    - JNF
    - Custom

#### **Water and Wastewater**

- Quality of drinking water
  - Source: Ministry of Health
- Quality of seawater at beaches
  - Source: Ministry of Health
- Quantity of treated effluents
  - Source: MoEP and The Shafdan project
- Water levels and salinity of aquifers and surface Water
  - Sources:
    - Water Authority
    - Kinneret Limnological Laboratory



## National water accountdetailed flows by industry (2008)

- > Economic flows
  - Sources:
    - Survey of water industry
    - Administrative data
    - Reports from the tax authority
- > Physical flows
  - Sources: Mainly the water Authority
- > Pollutants flows
  - Sources: Water Authority and waste survey

#### waste and Hazardous waste

- Solid domestic and commercial waste by districts
  - Sources: Local authorities and MoEP
- Recycling by material type
  - Source: MoEP, Recycling Plants
- > Hazardous waste by material and treatment types
  - Source: MoEP and: The Environmental Services Company (ESC), Ramat Hovav
- > Hazardous materials incidents
  - Source: MoEP

### Waste and Wastewater Survey

- Detailed data regarding the industrial sector:
- Waste generated by weight
- Waste treatment (recycle, reuse, landfills)
- Wastewater quantities
- Wastewater quality
- Wastewater destinations

# Sustainable Development Indicators

Data collection and generation of indicators regarding the following themes:

- > Environment
  - > salinity of groundwater
  - Population connected to wastewater treatment systems
- > Economics
  - Water abstraction per capita
  - Solid waste per capita
- > Society
  - expenditure for food by households deciles
  - Population growth
- Sources: Secondary data, ICBS



## Environmental expenditure

- Public expenditure (CBS)
- Manufacturing Industry (Survey)
- More sectors in the future...

## Biodiversity

- Risk of Extinction
  - > Animals
    - Vertebrates
    - Invertebrates
  - > Plants
    - Source: NPA and the Academia
- Protected Areas
  - Natural Reserves at different stages of declaration
  - National Parks
    - Source: NPA

  - Agriculture
  - Sanitation
  - Veterinary
- Agri-Environmental Indicators
  - Water and effluents use in agriculture
  - GHG in agriculture
  - Irrigation
  - N, P, K cycles
