1. General comments

This mission report was prepared within the EU Twinning Project "Support to the reform of the statistics system in Bosnia and Herzegovina". It was the fifth mission in the project and it was devoted to setting up the regional accounts within Component 1 National accounts.

The purposes of the mission were:

- O Discuss a list with number of multiregional business entities which have LKAU on the territory of other entity or BD for NACE A (incl.) F and list of multiregional bus entities of common interest in the BiH which belongs to NACE O and are compiled by BHAS. Inputs for those business entities were delivered to MS experts before the mission started.
- Setting up an experimental compilation of the regional accounts at NUTS II level for following activities NACE A (incl.) F and for NACE O. After the reviewing of all available data sources, MS experts recommended one of the method for regionalisation.
- Experimental compilation was conducted applying recommended method on multiregional business entities which belongs to above mentioned NACE activities
- Reviewing and analysis of the results from experimental compilation for mentioned NACE activities

Expected output of activity:

- Recommendations for establishing regional accounts made
- Test set of regional accounts for specific NACE activities made
- Input provided to the ToR of next activity

The consultants would like to express their thanks to all officials and individuals met for the kind support and valuable information which we received during the stay in Bosnia-Herzegovina and which highly facilitated the work of the consultants.

2. Assesment

The fifth mission of the project was held in Sarajevo and was attended by the BC experts from all the statistical offices (BHAS, BD, RSIS and FIS) together with MS experts. The main aim was to set up experimental regional calculation of certain NACE activities (from A to F and O).

2.1 Reviewing of delivered inputs to MS experts

One of the conclusions from the last mission was sending specific data to MS experts. Current data of calculated output, intermediate consumption and gross value added for years 2015 and 2016 from national accounts were delivered to MS experts. MS experts received mentioned categories by the FIS, RSIS and BD and total economy on 2.digit NACE level.

Furthermore, for NACE divisions A to (incl.) F all parties provided data for individual multiregional units that have their LKAU on the territory different that main activity is registered (on the territory of other entity and BD) (output, intermediate consumption, gross value added, number of employees, number of LKAU and number of employees in LKAU). Mentioned data were sent with some delay and were not unified in one document as previously agreed. During the mission some minor inconsistencies were noticed in the data MS experts received. Number of employees in LKAU was missing for some multiregional units. The agreement is to examine mentioned inconsistencies for the units with 5 and more employees in total and to send updated data with additional comments.

2.2 Setting up an experimental compilation of regional accounts

After the reviewing of all available data sources, MS experts recommended one of the method for regionalisation. According to the Manual on Regional Accounts methods, MS experts proposed method which has characteristics of pseudo-bottom-up and mixed method. The regionalisation of multiregional units is made using regional indicators per multiregional unit applied to P1, P2 and GVA. As a regional indicator, number of employees in LKAU is used. That indicator is applied due to the fact that it is only available data source acceptable for the regional accounts purposes which could be provided at all NUTS II levels.

During the mission experimental calculation of regional accounts for the NACE activities A was shown by MS experts. Following those principals, BC experts conducted experimental compilation for P1, P2 and GVA (for multiregional units) at NUTS II level, for NACE B to (incl.) F. MS experts made one common document with integrated experimental calculation data on categories on the NUTS II and mentioned NACE section level. This document was presented to all the participants and it is agreed that MS experts will deliver document to BC experts by 11th of February 2019.

Proposed method of the regional allocation was also planned to be conducted for the NACE O – for common institutions (multiregional units) at the level of BiH. During the mission MS experts findings were that more comprehensive data are needed to continue with experimental calculation for NACE O of regional accounts. Therefore, it was agreed that additional set of data for all units (not just for multiregional ones) that belongs to NACE O with current data of national accounts by FIS, RSIS, BD and BHAS will be delivered to MS experts for years 2015 and 2016. BC experts from RSIS express their concerning regarding the proposed method in a way that number of employees according to place of work is not appropriate indicator for regional allocation for the common

institutions at the level of BIH. Recommendation from the MS experts side is that they express their opinion on this topic via official canals.

3. Recommendations and conclusions

After the fifth mission has been carried out, MS experts recommended following steps:

- 1. BC experts have to examine inconsistencies noticed in the number of employees in LKAU (5 and more employees in total for the NACE A (incl.) F individual data with 2.-digit NACE code and update the list with additional comments (add 2.-digit NACE codes for all multiregional business units) if needed. Conducted exercise from this mission should be updated with a new set of data and delivered to MS experts by 15th of February.
- As input for the following mission it is recommended that BC experts deliver individual data on multiregional companies for 2015 and 2016 (ID number, NACE code (2.-digit), P1, P2, GVA, total number of employees, number of LKAU and number of employees in LKAU), NACE G - NACE U until 12th of April 2019.
- 3. Above mentioned inputs (point 2.) should be used in experimental compilation prepared by FIS, RSIS and BD- adjustments for P1, P2 and GVA on the level on business entity (NACE G (incl.) U and sent to MS experts by the 1st of May 2019. For the NACEs where common institutions are included, all institutions (BHAS, FIS, RSIS and BD) need to deliver data for their part of the total activity (P1, P2 and GVA).
- 4. For the following mission BHAS should also deliver current data from NA (2015 and 2016) for all common institutions at the level of BIH for which compilation is made by them and for which data are provided to entities and BD- individual data on all (uniregional and multiregional) companies (ID number, NACE code (2.-digit), P1, P2, GVA, total number of employees, number of employees in each entity and BD). Inputs should be sent to MS experts by 12th of April 2019.
- 5. Experimental compilation will be prepared by BHAS for common institutions at the level of BIH (uniregional and multiregional), P1, P2 and GVA on the level on business entity (NACE G (incl.) U and sent to MS experts by 1st of May 2019.
