## **EU Twinning Project on Statistics** in Bosnia and Herzegovina

### This is the sixth newsletter on the implementation of the project on Statistics in BiH

During the sixth project quarter, seven missions were carried out in BiH. The activities focused

- Setting up Regional Accounts
- Assessment and current status of Short Term Statistics (STS) and how to use administrative data sources for STS production
- IT upgrade of the Statistical business register (SBR)
- Preparation of regular survey Consumer Producer Prices Index (CPPI) for Civil Engineering
- Preparation of regular survey on Service Producer Prices Index (SPPI)
- Further analysis on regular survey on tourism statistics
- Data sources, production and balancing of quarterly International Investment Positions (IIPs)

The main purpose of the mission on Regional Accounts was to follow up on the experimental intermediate compilation output, consumption and gross value added. Furthermore, the mission focused on available data sources and the proposed method regarding employment (persons and hours worked), Gross Fixed Capital Formation and Compensation of Employees by NACE activity.

During the mission on administrative sources for the STS production, a number of important topics were discussed. The BC participants made an overview of the current practices of the production of STS indicators in BiH. It was concluded, that the production process should be significantly improved in the following areas: data collection method, introduction of administrative data sources for STS production, coverage, implementation of KAUs and

development of an appropriate IT solution.

For the IT upgrade of SBR, several decisions regarding the coverage and other issues were taken at the mission in order to describe the outline of the system to create Enterprise Group's and to include them in the SBR. Based on these decisions, the MS expert and the participants at the meeting built a model of how EGs may be constructed and maintained in SBR. The BC is expected to have a first version of the implementation of Enterprise Groups developed for the next mission.

For CPPI, SPPI and Tourism data has now been collected and focus has been on analyzing the process and the data quality. Moreover, recommendations have been made for topics like missing data, revisions policy and the weighting system for the deflator's calculation

The last mission on IIP has been held were the experts looked at the distinction between Money market funds and Investment funds, and finalized the methodological note on quarterly IIP. Work was also done on reviewing the collected data, strengthening of data sources, and treatment of missing data.

1. Regional Accounts

- 2. Statistical Business register (SBR) SBR will be further improved in line with EU regulation incl. looking into enterprise groups
- 3. Structural Business Statistics (SBS) SBS will be further developed in line with EU regulation. The use of administrative data and reducing response burden will be in focus
- 4. Price Indices (CPPI and SPPI)
