Card Sorting

- Simple method for defining and improving Information architecture when:
 - designing a new site
 - designing a new area of a site
 - redesigning a site
- Provides valuable input but will not tell you what's wrong with your current site





Card Sorting

Open Card

- Close Card
- Cards showing site Cards showing site content with no pre-established an groupings established initial set
- Users must sort cards into groups that the prime argroups appropriate and then describe each groupsers must place
