



## STATISTICIANS FROM UKRAINE AND THE EU WORKING TOGETHER ON BRINGING OFFICIAL STATISTICS IN LINE WITH EU STANDARDS

The EU-funded Twinning Project will improve Ukraine's macroeconomic and business statistics by aligning the SSSU activities and methodologies with the European Statistical Code of Practice (CoP), which set up standards for production and dissemination of official statistics.

Code of Practice states that statistics should be of

- high quality
- internationally comparable and
- easily accessible.

Thus, this project supports aligning of the Ukrainian statistics to relevant international standards.

## EXPECTED RESULTS

In particular, the project will result in:

- harmonisation of further indicators
- introduction of new concepts into statistical practice
- preparation of new quality Reports in various areas
- implementation of new communication strategy
- elaboration of a new SSSU web site
- introduction of staff training programme

## BUDGET AND DURATION

This Project is funded by the European Union, with a total value of EUR 1.5 million, started in November 2013. Duration: 24 months.

## TWINNING PROJECT CONCEPT

This EU funded Project aims at providing assistance to Ukraine in the ongoing process of strengthening institutional potential for collection, processing and dissemination of statistical data, better harmonisation of statistical methodology and techniques with European standards.

## OBJECTIVE

The objective of the Project is to contribute to an upgraded performance of official statistics in Ukraine, both at development of new statistical series and improvement of users' confidence in statistics through a better system of dissemination policy and marketing of statistical data, with a view to meeting the international and EU standards.
