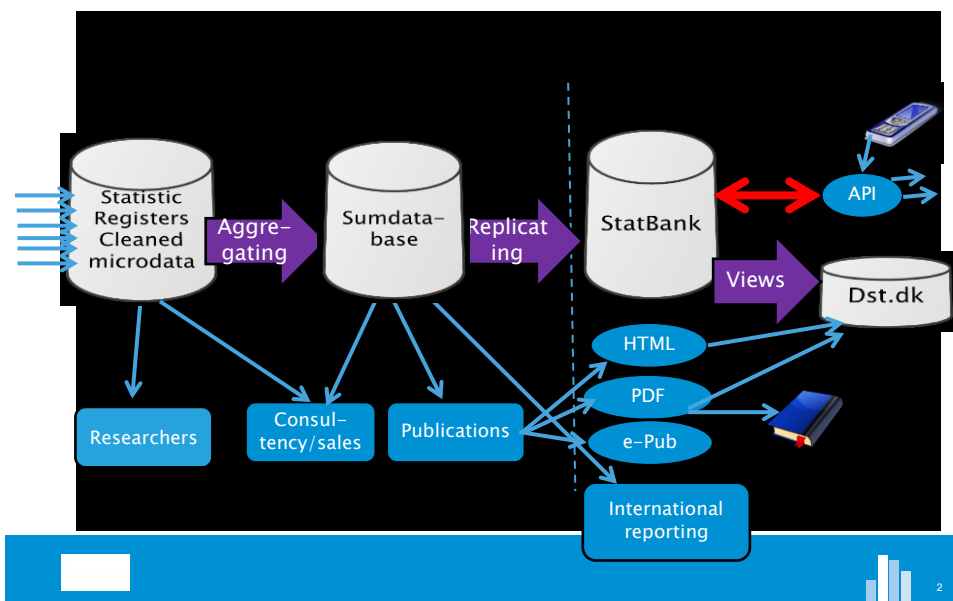

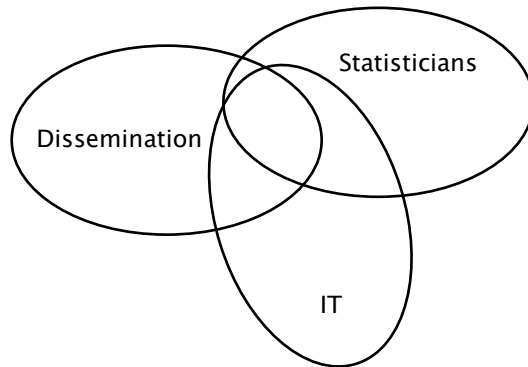


Metadata

Table Reference:

1. Table reference consists of up to 8 characters, and must not start with a number. Table reference is unique in Statistics Bank, it can be said in the name, eg BEF for a table to the subject population.

Variable:

2. How many distribution variables (the variables), shall the table contain . Which headlines are needed. Note : Variable Headings and the number of variables can NOT be changed once the table is created.

The timeline :

3. When should the table be published, and how far in advance do you need a table to test the data ? If you are unsure of the date of publication contact your contact person in the Data Banks.

Language :

4. Remember, Statistics Denmark has two languages : English and Danish. Both the table title, values , variable titles to be translated into English. Contact possibly Salaries translator Poul Erik Olsen (PEO).

Table Title:

5. Table title consists of the short presentation text and variable headers. The short presentation text is a count of the table. "Automatic Presentation Text " to form the table title. So are you sure it complies with state nature. Think about what you count and do not write the word "Number " in the table title.

Variables and values :

6. In Statistics Denmark we have common metadata. This means that we share values and variable headers. Consider , therefore, what tables you want to share values with .
