1. General comments

This mission report was prepared within the Twinning Project "Support to Statistics". It was the seventh mission to be devoted to the Statistical Business Register (SBR) within Component 3 of the project.

During this mission the procedures for updating with data from KBRA and TAX was reviewed as well as the procedures to handle the use of activity codes and data on turnover/employment from surveys. Special attention was given to unfinished transactions.

The consultant would like to express their thanks to all officials and individuals met for the kind support and valuable information which they received during the stay in Kosovo, and which highly facilitated the work of the consultants.

This views and observations stated in this report are those of the consultant and do not necessarily correspond to the views of EU, KAS or Statistics Denmark.

2. Status

The load of data KBRA and TAX was once again reviewed and executed with some minor correction, most important for units changing fiscal number, that was not handed correct in the first version.

The procedures for loading activity codes from surveys were changed. The main problem was to correctly handle multiple activity codes (second activity and other activities). These activity codes can (in accordance with the EU guidelines) only be assigned from surveys. However, it is important to ensure, that only 1 survey is used as the source for all activity code, i.e. it must not be possible to assign the main activity code from 1 survey and then add secondary activity codes from other surveys.

3. Handling unfinished transactions

As discussed in the previous report, some updates from KBRA cannot be carried out automatically for the statistical units. Instead they create an unfinished transaction that has to be handled manually.

A closer look on some of these unfinished transactions was taken in order to examine if they included cases, where rules for automatic update could be established and implemented. For those changing fiscal number it was found that the majority could be handled automatic and this was implemented.

It may be possible to further reduce the number of unfinished transaction by finding patterns that can be detected and will lead to the same processing and thus can be handled automatic.

4. Creating KAUs

This issue is discussed in the previous report but there has not been any progress.

The issue is still waiting for KAS to discuss the issue (availability of data and responsibility for handling these data).

When KAS has discussed to issue it should be handled in a future mission.

5. Potential change in administrative system

KAS has received information that KBRA and TAX has initiated a discussion on using a common identification number to replace the BR-number and the Fiscal Number.

It is at this moment not clear if this will lead to changes in the types of units being recorded by KBRA/TAX.

KAS should seek more information regarding this project and the most likely outcome in order to prepare for such changes.

The most likely outcome seems to be that there will not be any radical changes to the way data from administrative sources are used, but more knowledge on the subject is needed.

6. Online application

KAS has produced a first draft for the application that was discussed during the mission.

It should be recalled that update should be restricted to the statistical units and should be carried out using stored procedures (similar to those used for handling data from KBRA) in order to ensure the integrity of the system.

The issued will be further addressed during next mission.

7. Next mission.

The next mission, to be carried out by Søren Netterstrøm is scheduled to take place from 26 October 2015.

Last mission were primarily devoted to deal with problems during update of SBR with new data from KBRA and to establish a fully updated version of SBR ready for use.

Also a short workshop was held with key users demonstrating the possibility to use an Excel application to create standard extracts from SBR. This approach needs further fine tuning, both to the content and in order to meet requirements for data security (confidentiality). This mission will work further with these issues.

The issue of KAU (needed by National Account) will have to be further examined.

The next step in the development of SBR will be to create an online application for browsing and updating SBR. During the mission the scope of this application should be discussed and a first draft plan should be produced. It will also have to be examined if the resources and skills required are available in order to develop such an application.
