Introduction

- The business register is the basis of all statistics compiled on enterprises, which contains:
 - Information on legal units, statistical units and kind-of-activity units
 - Branch/industry information according to the Danish branch classification (which is a refinement of NACE rev2) and sector code according to ESA2010
 - Turnover and employees (in man-years)
 - Tracking of changes in activity

Summary of the business structure

- Many business in S.11 and S.14. We have lots of self-employed businesses in Denmark.
- S.11 has the most employees but S.13 has 35 %.
- S.11 generates most of the turnover
- If balance sheet information was available S.127 would probably account for a significant amount because of the holding companies.
