Survey "Enterprise Labour Costs"

- Survey is conducted once in four years. At first it was conducted in 2007.
 Second survey was conducted in 2011.
- The purpose of survey is to receive the data on volume and components of enterprise labour costs.
- Main indicators calculated on the survey data:
 - Number of employees
 - Paid working time based on one employee
 - Labour cost structure
 - Labour costs based on one employee
 - Labour costs based on one paid hour


Structure of Labour Costs for 2010 (in %)

Arrangement of Survey

- Survey is conducted on a sampling basis. The unit of observation is a legal entity or its separate division.
- Total population is generated on the basis of business-register at national level. It includes the business entities with a number of employees 10+, excluding the agricultural, forestry, hunting and fishery entities as well as state governance institutions (NACE sections: A, B Ta L). State and municipal organisations are not subject to survey.
- Enterprises with a number of employees 250+ are surveyed on a total basis but enterprises with a number of employees 10 – 249 inclusive – based on sampling method.

Sampling is Generated under Procedure of Stratified Random Selection



Tools and Instructive Materials of Survey

- The data are collected through questionnaire being drafted by SSSU.
 Enterprises submit to the statistics offices the completed questionnaires not later than 7 April after the reporting year.
- Instructive materials:
 - Employee Number Statistics Instruction
 - Salary Statistics Instruction
 - Instruction how to complete the questionnaire

- In 2011 for survey 17297 enterprises were selected; it made up 22,7% of total population. Of those 12900 – with a number of employees 10-249 persons, 4397 – 250+ persons.
- 16282 enterprises or 94,1% of the selected enterprises took part in the survey.
- The received estimates for most of the indicators are sufficiently reliable (variation ratio does not exceed 5%).
