Collect more Microdata and Publish indicators




Projects initiated

From 1. januar 2013:

- Support given to families will be reported on the micro level.(CPR-number)
- Data collection will be electronic


From 2013 - CPR - Key-variable

 Municipalities must from 1 January 2013 report all services along with information about the social security number for the child receiving help. (Data from 1. January 2012)






Source register: 98 local registers (municipalities)






Six different system suppliers + Web

Web or systems used in the municipalities




Differences in the suppliers software system






Transportation of standardised XML-datafiles



Error Detection

- Every night input data:
 - Email automatically to the municipalities
 - Technical errors
 - Missing values and codes
 - Metadata
 - Personal Identification Number
 - Company Identification Number
 - Negative figures
 - -

Also an email with acceptence of the delivery



Error Detection – input data

- Every month: A report with graphics and tables
- Three times per year: missing data?
- Every Year starting in January:
 - Error detection for all data from all the municipalities
 - A letter including graphics and tables. Ask them to accept/validate the data.
 - Looking for decreases and increases in the data. Looking both 2 years back - but also 5 years.



ERRORS – input data

BIG

- Missing values for the private suppliers
- Differences in the suppliers software system
- People in the municipalities are not well-trained with IT
- The Municipalities cannot recognize their data

MINOR

- Often missing values for all month
 - Use an average for the year
- Referral and delivered data do not match
- Dead people
- Not valid Personal Identification Number
- Not valid Company Identification Number
- Unbelievably big data

Quality Assurance

- After acceptance of the Municipalities different quality reports are made:
 - Last years statistics
 - Statistics in other municipalities
 - Male/female, age groups, private suppliers, time groups
 - Using figures in percentage and total:
 - Average help
 - Number of hours
 - Number of people




Lessons learned

- The quality of data are varying between the municipalities
- Many problems with the suppliers of the it-systems
- Using much, much time on editing data
- When the municipalities change their it-system we often miss data or get data on excel




The Production Model






