The Possibilities of Satellite Accounts

- The accounts are prepared in the framework of the National accounts and using national accounts definitions
- The accounts include detailed data on income and expenditure.
- In some accounts (R&D for example) we present a matrix showing a cross-classification of financing and performing sectors.
- Welfare Accounts in Other Countries.

Time series on R&D

- Series of National expenditure on R&D in current and constant prices were prepared by the Central Bureau of Statistics since 1989.
- Includes preliminary estimates for the last years.
- Series were prepared in a consistent manner with the national accounts and according to the OECD's methodology that has been published in the Frascati manual.

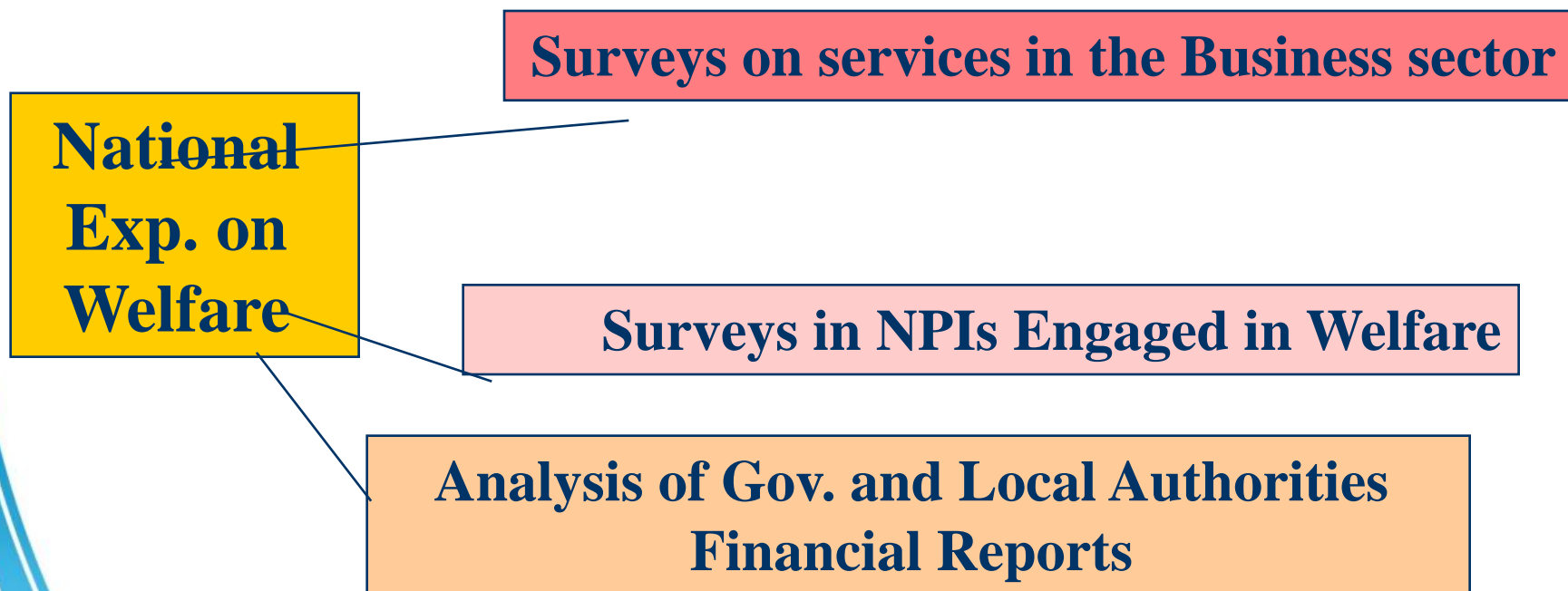

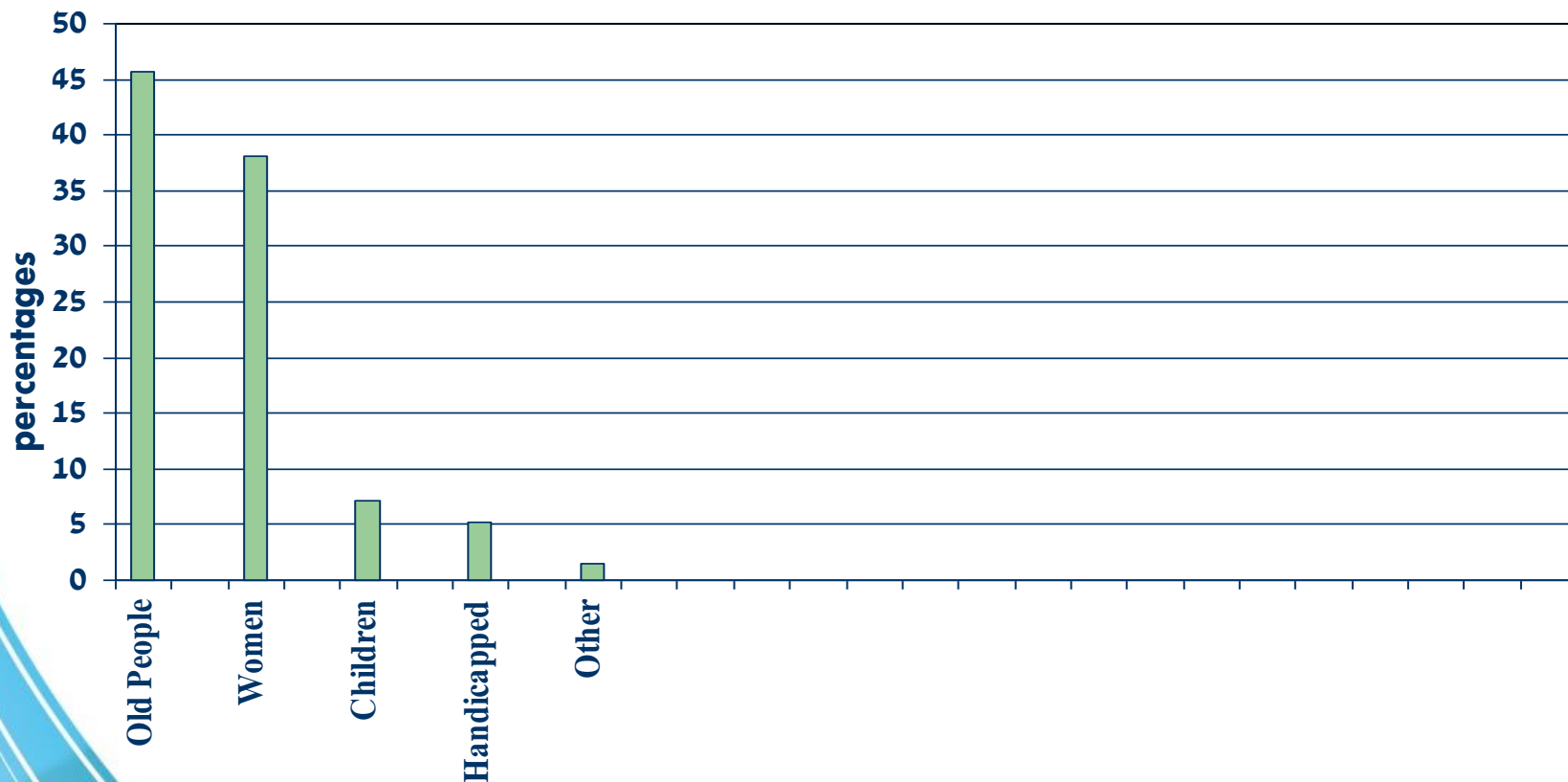

International Comparisons

- Data found for : Denmark, Japan, Ireland, China, Finland, Canada.
- Main Indicators –Total Expenditure and its Growth, Individual Income and Poverty, Deprivation indicators, Profile of Population at Risk of Poverty, Disabled Persons, Security Benefits by groups (child care, women, disabled etc.), Employees, etc.

Many Options for International Comparisons

- Welfare Expenditure as percent of GDP.
- Welfare Expenditure per capita.
- Welfare expenditure by Sector of Performance and Type of Activity (or purpose).
- Welfare expenditure by Sector of Finance.
- Human Resources Dedicated to Welfare, by Occupation, Education and Gender.
- Distribution of Welfare allowances by group (child care, women etc.).
- Expenditure per capita - based on the number of patients in each group (data to be collected through questionnaires).
