- Time series 1994 – 2012
 - Revised production method 2007 – 2012
- Statistical release annually: April
 - Lead time 15 – 16 months
- Base SAS application
 - Excel in collection and publication phase
 - PX-Edit and Arbortext Editor in publication phase

Data sources and data collection

- Accounting data of central government – State Treasury
 - Budget economy
- Data on environmental subsidies for agriculture – Information Centre of the Ministry of Agriculture and Forestry
- Supplementary data from ministries
 - Ministry of Agriculture and Forestry
 - Ministry of Employment and the Economy
 - Ministry of Finance
 - Ministry for Foreign Affairs
- Data from the statistics on the finances and activities of municipalities and joint municipal boards
 - Public-service companies included

Variables and classification (1)

- Expenditure type
 - Based on sums of transaction codes of national accounts in data of central government
 - Based on sums of expense and revenue items in municipal data
- Environmental domain
 - Rough classification based on The classification of Environmental Protection Activities and Expenditure (CEPA 2000)

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Data editing and analysis (1)

- Accounting data of central government
 - transaction (and function) codes added by government finance team
- Budget analysis: selection of sub-items
 - I. primary purpose is environmental protection
 - II. at least half of the allowance is aimed at environmental protection
- Supplementary data from ministries
 - the proportion of environmental protection expenses
- Environmental domains added for sub-items in a budget

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Data editing and analysis (2)

- Detailed data on environmental subsidies for agriculture
 - Expenditure calculated by subsidy type
 - Environmental domain and transaction code added
 - Calculation of proportions financed nationally / by European Union
 - Accordance with accounting data checked
- Data from municipal statistics
 - Activity classes in data: environmental protection (including nature protection), water management, waste management → environmental domain
 - Coefficients estimated to calculate proportion of waste water management based on water management data


Data editing and analysis (3)

- Update of the SAS application
 - Sub-items of the budget, environmental domains, coefficients...
- Computation of results
 - Base SAS application comprises three modules
 - Central government
 - Municipalities and joint municipal boards
 - Consolidation
- Excel, PX-Edit and Arbortext Editor in publication phase




Public sector environmental protection expenditure by expenditure type, 2007 – 2012 (consolidated total)




Public sector environmental protection expenditure by environmental domain, 2012 (consolidated total)

Module for EPEA – Annex IV

- The new regulation entered into force 16 June 2014 and amended previous regulation on European environmental economic accounts

 - The new modules are fully in line with SEEA and ESA
- The 1st official EPEA data transmission in December 2017
 - Annual data 2014 – 15

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EU regulation / Module for EPEA

– List of required characteristics

- Output of EP services
 - Market output, non-market output
- Gross fixed capital formation and acquisition less disposals of non-financial, non-produced assets for the production of EP services
- Final consumption of EP services
- EP transfers (received / paid)
 - In coverage also the rest of the world required
- Etc.

- The final questionnaire is not yet available

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EU regulation / Module for EPEA

- Data shall be reported in a breakdown by classes of the CEPA
 - 2 – Wastewater management
 - 3 – Waste management
 - 1 + 4 + 5 + 7
 - 6 – Protection of biodiversity and landscapes
 - 8 + 9 – Environmental R&D + Other EP activities

Other development needs (1)

- Revision of the European System of Accounts, ESA 2010
 - The EU will move to the new system at the end of September 2014
 - Statistics Finland published ESA 2010 accordant national accounts statistical releases and time series 11 Jul 2014
 - Changes also to statistics on public sector's environmental protection expenditure
- Environmental research and development
 - For now estimate by Statistical Methods unit
 - In future expenditure type required
 - Use of official statistics on research and development?

- Estimate for waste water management in municipal data
- Computation of environmental subsidies for agriculture
- SAS Enterprise Guide application
- Publication phase by SAS
