The Armenian ILC has very extensive contents, and covers well also many aspects of social exclusion High quality report "Social Snapshot and Poverty in Armenia" Respondent burden cannot be increased (much)

Focus areas for social exclusion measurement:

- 1) cross-national comparability
- 2) expanding on measurement of child social exclusion
- Convergence towards EU social exclusion measurement using existing European questions on social exclusion (whole population, children)
- \rightarrow First stage: pilot, module in 2016 ILC survey
- Second stage: adaptation of main questionnaire of ILC 2017, integrating module questions to main questionnaire to the extent possible



Fieldwork:

- Pilot in October 2015, 48 households, selected from July sample
- Must be completed before next mission 2nd week of November

Questionnaire:

- Covers material deprivation items of EU at risk of poverty or social exclusion measure (AROPE)
- 20 questions for the whole population (15 at household level, 5 for all adults 16 +) → MD indicator
- Child material deprivation questions (6), experimental (not for child MD indicator)

Next mission: analyse the pilot results, discuss with Unicef on the child questions, select module questions for 2016
