441 unique filenames273 active filenames

Work process

- Data available intern Statistics NL
 - Data Service Center (DSC);
 - Administrated in Commence;
 - Transpose micro- and meta-data to standard format
 - Micro- and Metadata available for projects



From DSC to RA-environment 1

- Get notification by e-mail dataset is available
- Administrate in Commence
- Starting the documentation process
- Using tools to transpose the microdata and metadata to standard format for RA/OS environment.
 - Microdata to SPSS file by batch
 - Metadata to PDF file



From DSC to RA-environment 2

- Place files in the intern environment and the secured environment .
- Notify the active projects who are granted on this file
- If its an new version, we give the reason of the version usually its from provisional changed into definite.
- If its an new period than it speak for itself.

Key variables 1

- Persons identified by:
 - **RINPERSOONS and RINPERSOON**
 - RINPERSOONS together with the RINPERSOON, identifies a natural person. The code indicates the source (register) from which the personal ID is derived.
- Households identified in some datasets by:
 - RINPERSOONSKERN and RINPERSOONKERN, which is the key/identifier of the household.



Key variables 2

- Addresses identified by :
 - SOORTOBJECTNUMMER and RINOBJECTNUMMER
- Companies identified by:
 - Business Identification Number (BE_ID)
 - or Chamber of Commerce file number (KvK)
 - or Tax Identification Number (Finr)



datasets research project

- Importing own datasets
- Instructions for file format and upload process
- anonymise datasets and create the link with the relevant CBS microdata
- In 2016 it concerns about 120 data files
