1. General comments

This mission report was prepared within the Twinning Project "Support to Statistics". It was the first mission to be devoted to Direct User Communication within Component 4.8 of the project. The mission was aimed at defining a strategic plan forming the base of the further implementation of the project in this statistical area.

The concrete objectives of the mission were:

A A	To prepare and conduct a training course for students at the University of Pristina.			
The training couse covered the following subjects:				
•	Sources for European Statistics			
•	Available statistics for Kosovo			
•	How to understand statistics / How NOT to use statistics			

The consultant would like to express his/her thanks to all officials and individuals met for the kind support and valuable information which he/she received during the stay in Kosovo, and which highly facilitated the work of the consultant.

2. Assessment and results

The course was held at the Faculty of Economics at the University of Pristina. About 200 students participated, as well as Professor Rahmije Mustafa. The presentation itself can be found attached in Annex 3. The KAS part was presented by Mrs. Hazbije Qeriqi, Communication Officer, KAS. The Eurostat part was presented by Mrs. Lone Schlüter, Head of Section, DST and Mrs. Sanne Nielsen, Head of Section, DST made a brief introduction to Twinning.

During the presentation we experienced some internet problems, which made it hard to keep the students' attention. But in general, they were good sports, and afterwards Mrs. Hazbije Qeriqi Communication Officer, KAS has received many requests from students wanting to connect with her, showing an interest in the content of the course.

Professor Rahmije Mustafa expressed that she was very pleased with the presentation, and that she thinks that there should be a yearly course for new students included in the curriculum, ensuring that all students have basic knowledge of retrieving descriptive statistics.

The presentation will be made available to the students afterwards, including the links to both KAS as well as Eurostat resources.

The KAS staff was very eager to commit to this mission, although their workload made it challenging to participate through the entire workshop. While preparing the course the MS experts shared information on DST direct user communication initiatives, as well as how to meet the users' information needs.

3. Conclusions and recommendations

It is recommended to continue both the development of courses as well as the good relationship with the university.

Following should be considered in the development:

- To keep contact with the university. This is an important way to teach future policy makers to find and use official statistics.
- To know the students' interests and papers due to finding subjects and themes, that are of relevance to their immediate information needs. To use examples meaningful to them, will ensure relevance of the course.
- When the KAS PX-web database has been made public, the students could benefit from a course based on the functionalities of PX-web.
- Expand the course activity to include not only the public university, but also the private ones.
- Work on a technical solution, where the internet connection is not dependent of location infrastructure.
- In this regard also consider to use slides with many screen-dumps, if the internet connection is known to be unstable.
- Keep it simple. The content of the course is very complex. Better to have all students understanding a simple version, then a few students understanding a complex version
- Consider expanding direct communication to other target groups e.g. the Parliament, Governmental institutions etc.

KAS will brief the MS experts on the current state of direct user communication: Courses, user meetings etc. A course for the students within the economic fields of University of Pristina will be prepared and conducted. The course will be prepared and conducted in cooperation between KAS staff and the MS experts.

The MS -experts will brief KAS staff on Statistics Denmarks dissemination policy and direct user communication initiatives. KAS and the MS representatives will generate a matrix of current KAS practices and Statistics Denmarks practice in the field of dissemination / user communication. The matrix will be used as tool to indicated priorities and action areas for the the Twinning project period.

In order to suggest improvements for the direct user communication done by KAS –KAS is asked to brief the MS experts on any regular user contacts arrangements.

Presentation / lecture on Statistical sources prepared and conducted at the University of Kosovo at Pristina. Duration 1 - 1,5 hour.
