General comments

The agenda of this second mission on tourism statistics had to be changed to a large extent for several reasons. Firstly, the expert from Italy who was foreseen to contribute to this mission was not able to attend the meeting and a replacement could not be found on a short term perspective. Secondly, it was agreed upon at the first mission to have a meeting with the stakeholders of BiH tourism to discuss with them their information needs and priorities concerning the pilot survey on travel behaviour of the BiH population and the current situation of accommodation statistics. However, it was not possible to organise this meeting in preparation of this mission. Furthermore, clarifications related to the conduct of the envisaged pilot survey on tourism behaviour have not been conducted before this mission as it was concluded at the first mission. This refers to the funding of such a pilot survey as well as to organisational aspects (separate survey or embedding of the survey in any other already existing survey).

In consequence of that it was necessary to revise the agenda considerably. At the suggestion of the RTA all items related to demand side issues of tourism statistics were deleted from this mission's agenda and postponed to the next mission taking place in the month of June. Hence, the focus of this mission was laid on two issues:

- Training in tourism statistics methodology (which was also a topic of the original agenda)
- Support for the improvement of the existing survey on tourism (accommodation statistics), bringing it in line with EU requirements and standards as laid down in EU regulation No 692/2011

On two days the meetings was also attended by two representatives of the EU funded project "Technical Assistance to Support Tourism Industry in Bosnia and Herzegovina". It was concluded to continue cooperation between the two projects as it was assessed this could be of mutual benefit for both sides.

Training on Tourism Statistics Methodology

This item of the agenda was attended also by two representatives of the EU funded project "Technical Assistance to Support Tourism Industry in Bosnia and Herzegovina", Ms. Mary McKeon and Mr. Alessandro Guzzo.

A presentation was given by the expert on basic concepts and sources of tourism statistics. The main issues to be discussed were:

- The economic impact of tourism
- The statistical definition of tourism
- The visitor concept
- The concept of usual evironment
- Forms and concepts of tourism
- Internal versus national tourism
- Sources of tourism statistics
- Core variables in different statistical sources

In a bilateral meeting with the expert the representatives of the EU project expressed their interest to organise such a presentation on tourism statistics methodology in the framework of their tourism working group. It was agreed that a cooperation of both projects could be of mutual benefit.

The second presentation as part of the training activities was about the German accommodation statistics. Some issues that were raised in this context were:

- The definition of the statistical unit
- Way of reporting
- Three different questionnaires for respective NACE divisions
- Presentation and publication of the results
- The use of register information

One focus of this presentation was laid on specific methods applied in Germany to enrich the statistical information on tourism through the combination of information derived from two registers, one concerning the establishments and the other containing information on the municipalities. By this method it is possible to obtain additional information on different types of tourism without additional burden for the respondents.

Improvement of BiH Accommodation Statistics

The second main issue of this mission was the improvement of the current system of accommodation statistics in BiH. In preparation of this topic the relevant questionnaires and instructions that are in use in the two entities and the Brcko district were transmitted in English translation to the expert. The classification of types of accommodation applied in BiH was checked for its compliance with the NACE Rev 2 classification.

- Currently, a unique national administrative classification does not exist in BiH. The BiH accommodation statistics for the time being refers to two entity level administrative categorisations of types of accommodation. The EU regulation requires a data transmission according to the NACE Rev 2 classification consisting of three divisions for the accommodation statistics. Therefore it is necessary to draft a correspondence table providing a link between both classifications, the European NACE Rev 2 classification on the one hand a nd the classification(s) applied in BiH on the other hand. The assignment of the national classification to the three NACE divisions was intensively discussed. Two items were identified that are not covered by the scope of the EU regulation (Vessel cabins and sleeping cars). One accommodation group consisting of private rooms, apartments flats, etc. was identified as running risk for producing a double counting. It was concluded in preparation of the next mission to draft a correspondence table linking the national classification with the NACE classification.
- The current design of the questionnaire for the data collection of accommodation statistics was examined on the background of the requirements of the EU regulation. Several items were identified that are not covered by the EU requirements and should be checked for still being necessary:
 - o The triple question concerning the activity
 - Question concerning the facility
 - Question concerning the seasonal character of the business

It was agreed to revise the questionnaire on the basis of this meetings discussion and to submit a new draft version to the next mission.

- Concerning the countries of origin of the guests the following list was identified that has to be added being in line with the EU requirements:
 - o Cyprus
 - o Estonia

- o Latvia
- o Lithuania
- o Malta
- o Ukraine
- o Africa
- o To be reported separately: Republic of South Africa
- North America
- o South and Central America
- o To be reported separately: Brazil
- o Asia
- o To be reported separately: Republic of South Korea
- o Australia, Oceania and other Territories

Besides, a footnote has to be introduced to include Liechtenstein into the figures for Switzerland.

It was agreed that a revised list of countries of origin will be drafted before the next mission.

• The usefulness of 3 tables concerning data collection on revenues, data on employees and data on mode of tourist arrival was examined. These data are not required by the EU regulation. The pros and cons of this data collection were discussed. It was concluded to continue this discussion internally with other units of the BHAS as some of these variables are also collected within other statistical surveys.
