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Recent application of the GSBPM in Istat


- Mapping of activities to the GSBPM started in Directorate for Data Collection, in September 2016
- ✓ The Data Collection Directorate represents a major change of the re-organisation that took place in April 2016
 - Big change in the production process but also a big cultural change for a lot of people
 - Need to better understand who does what: responsibilities, work flows, procedures,...
- ✓ The GSBPM provides an international framework for rationalising the activities and for supporting the transition



Recent application of the GSBPM in Istat


- Version 1.0 of the Mapping of Data collection Directorate (DCRD) to GSBPM was adopted by Istat and published on Istat intranet (July 2017)
- ✓ The Mapping to GSBPM has been extended to other Directorates
 - Directorate for Methodology and Statistical Process Design (DCME)
 - Directorate for information and communication technology (DCIT)
- ✓ The work is still in progress







Mapping of the Directorate for Data Collection





What has been done in the mapping for the Data Collection Directorate

For each sub-process

- ✓ Definition of tasks
- Exploitation of the activities (within the task) for Data Collection Directorate - "who does what"
- Assigning responsibilities for each task among different directorates
- Highlighting cross-cutting activities (for more than one process)

2.3 Design Collection - Tasks

- ✓ Definition of the collection method
- Design of collection instruments, questions and response templates
- Design of any formal agreements relating to data supply
- ✓ Confirmation of legal basis for data collection
- Design of process-specific provider management systems
- ✓ Re-use of known methods and collection systems


