Executive Summary

Study visit for Agency for Statistics of Bosnia and Herzegovina, Institute for Statistics of Federation of Bosnia and Herzegovina, Institute for Statistics of Republika Srpska and Central Bank of Bosnia and Herzegovina was organized in order to introduce participants with current practice and experiences in implementation ESA 2010.

The following topics were covered:

- 1. Introduction to Statistics Finland
- 2. Back-casting methods
- 3. Estimation of non-observed and illegal activities
- 4. FISIM calculations
- 5. Cooperation with Central Bank and the Ministry of Finance
- 6. PIM model, consumption of fixed capital
- 7. SDMX-reporting
- 8. VAT base calculations

1. General comments

This report was prepared within the Twinning Project "Support to the State and Entity Statistical Institutions, phase VI". It was the Study visit to Statistics Finland on NA within Component 1 National Account of the project.

The purposes of the mission were:

- Presentation of the Finnish National accounts comparison with the system in BiH
- Possibilities for applying calculation methods applied in Statistics Finland
- Discussions on concrete issues regarding implementation of IPA 2012 Project and its role in development of BiH statistics

BC experts (participants of the study visit) would like to express big gratitude to all officials and individuals met, for good organisation, kind support and valuable information received during the study visit.

2. Lessons Learned

In the first day of the study visit participants were introduced with information on historical development, organisational structure, operation and resources of Statistics Finland. Participants were also informed about Finnish National Accounts, their organisation, areas in compilation, sources, work process, timetable and dissemination. In comparison with statistical system in Bosnia and Herzegovina, in Finland a significant flow of data comes from administrative sources. An expert also presented calculation mechanisms in the IT system. Participants were introduced to two different ways

for back-casting with practical examples related to implementation of NACE Rev.2, capitalisation of military and research and development expenditures. In the process of implementation ESA 2010, back-casting is one of the biggest problems, especially in calculation of consumption of fixed capital. Participants were also able to see theoretical background for estimation of non-observed and illegal activities with main data sources.

The second day of the study visit was dedicated for FISIM, capital stock model and SDMX-reporting. Experts presented historical overview and development of available data sources for FISIM calculations. Special attention was devoted to cooperation with the Central Bank and the Ministry of Finance as co-producers of financial statistics, data suppliers and users of data. BiH has only made experimental calculations of consumption of fixed capital, and participants were especially interested to introduce the Finnish experiences in capital stock calculations in BiH. Next topic was SDMX-reporting. Participants realised the importance of SDMX for data exchange with Eurostat and other international institutions.

During the third day experts presented VAT-base calculations. The expert from the Ministry of Finance explained calculating VAT own resources base. Afterward, expert from Statistics Finland presented calculation of Weighted Average Rate, main sources and calculation methods. We were also able to see practical examples of calculation of tax base for intermediate consumption of NPISH. The next session was reserved for estimation of housing output, where experts presented main sources and steps in calculation of housing in Finland. The last session was dedicated to concluding remarks and planning of forthcoming activities.

3. Conclusions and recommendations

- 1. We gained a lot of knowledge and useful experiences during this Study visit. Different topics covered in the study visit are directly related to our activities that will be carried out through our IPA 2012 Project.
- 2. BC will consider the possibility to implement similar procedures used by Statistics Finland in BiH statistical system which will contribute to further harmonization of BiH statistics with EU requirements.
