

Price-structure at Statistics Denmark

Researchers just pay for three things:

Public researchers pay 1150 Dkr (private 1750 Dkr) per **hour we work on their projects**

All researchers pay for **storage of data** if it exceeds 5 GB. They pay 25 Dkr per additional 5GB quarterly

Private researchers pay 180 Dkr per day per researcher that has been **logged on**

Other possibilities for payment

- Payment for establishing an access for an organisation
- Payment for maintaining access for an organisation
- Payment for actual use of remote access per researcher or project
- Payment for using the Research room per hour
- Payment for sending output "home" to researcher
- Payment for handling breaches

Services sold to researchers	11 mio.Dkr
Storage of data	1 mio.Dkr
Private researchers logon	1 mio.Dkr
Contribution from the "law-model"	1 mio.Dkr
Income in all	21 mio.Dkr
