Recommendations (1)

Communication and Dissemination Strategy (1)

- Develop action plan as a seperate document (End of 2016)
 - For 2017: A specific and realistic action plan
 - For 2018-2020: Broader descriptions of intended actions to take
- Review/evaluate action plan after one year when drafting next years action plan. After this evaluation take place every two years. (2017)
- Evaluate the Communication and Dissemination Strategy on last Twinning mission in 2017
 - Does it comply with your needs? Does the structure or initiatives need to be modified or changed?



Recommendations (2)

Communication and Dissemination Strategy (2)

- Swap titles on dissemination "Strategy" and "Policy" documents (ASAP)
- Consider introducing social medias (e.g. Twitter, LinkedIn or Facebook) as tools of communication directly with users (2016)
 - When social medias will be introduced, include a chapter in the Communication and Dissemination Strategy about the plans for the use of social medias
- Link main communication and dissemination strategy to substrategies (e.g. Agricultural Census dissemination Strategy) (2016)



Recommendations (3)

Trust survey

- Conduct light-version of (Danish) trust survey in addition to user surveys
 - In 2017 and in 2020 in order to compare results over time
 - Use OECD recommendations for international comparison

Recommendations (4)

Tailor-made statistics (1)

- Tailor-made statistics "free of charge" must be based on most frequently demanded figures
- Cooperate with NSSRA library and specialists in information search in NSSRA to identify and classify the highest demanded statistics (based on FAQ)
- Develop a standardized tool for communicating with users regarding requests for tailor-made statistics
 - The sub-component on improvement of the NSSRA websites could integrate this aspect, based on inspiration from Statistics Denmark's template and 'Help Spot' system



Recommendations (5)

Tailor-made statistics (2)

- Test Statistics Denmark's "Questions"-functionality by asking a specific question on the website
- Develop and launch first version of a "Tailor-made statistics and information service" page on Armstat.am
- Consider at a later stage to establish a blog on armstat.am to have a more direct dialogue with the users regarding highly demanded statistics

Initiate work in 2016
Collection and classification of FAQ's before last mission in 2017



Recommendations (6)

Access to administrative data

- Follow-up on the current MoU with the Ministry of Nature Protection (End of 2016)
- Plan for a practical pilot test of exchange of data (End of 2016)
- Consider the capacity of the NSSRA IT-division, the current IT-infrastructure and the cooperation between the ITdepartment and the statistical units in order to be well prepared for the future digitalization of the statistical production processes (ASAP)
